Shopping Bus

We offer regular shopping trips in our Community Transport buses to near-by shopping centres.

We collect you from your home in the morning, take you out for a couple of hours and return you safely by lunchtime.

A volunteer assistant is onboard and can support you to get on and off the bus, as well as help load your shopping onto the bus and carry it to your door.

We provide monthly, fun social outings on the fourth Tuesday of every month, with pick ups in Bangalow, Byron Bay, Mullumbimby, Brunswick Heads, Ocean Shores and New Brighton.

This is a great way to get out of the house, make new friends and see some of our beautiful countryside.

An attendant is on board to assist you. Passengers are picked up at home and go out for the day, stopping at interesting places and enjoying a pleasant morning tea and lunch and returned to your door mid-late afternoon.

To use our service, you must be registered as a client. If you already use community transport, simply dial the number above. Otherwise, please contact My Aged Care on 1300 552 961 and ask for a referral to Tweed Byron and Ballina Community Transport

Once you are registered, you can choose to catch the bus on a regular basis, or just occasionally. You can also access our other transport services such as individual transport and taxi vouchers.
