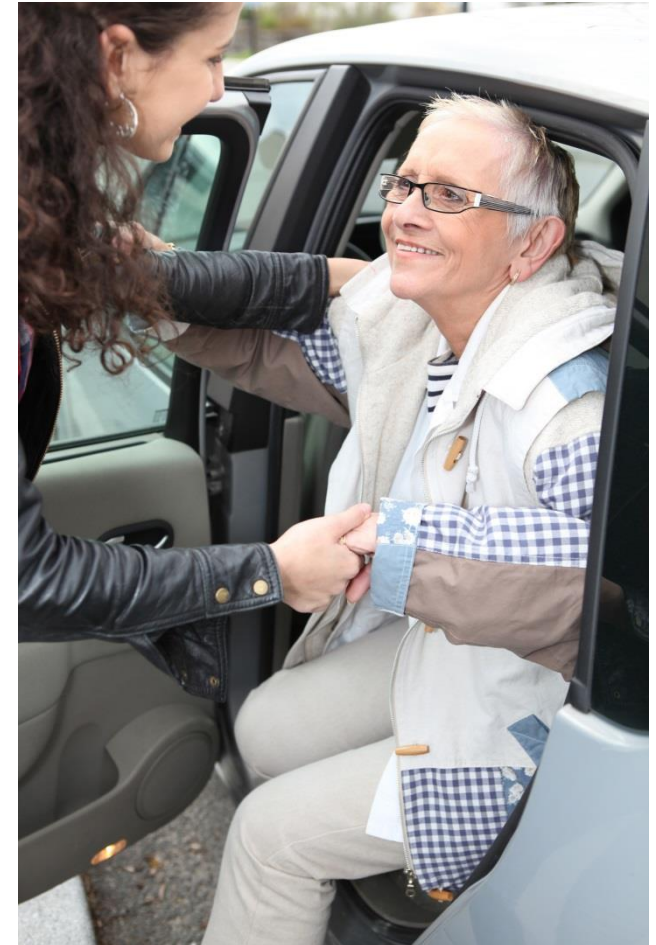

Our Bus Volunteers

Our bus trips provide monthly, door-to-door social outings and fortnightly shopping and access trips. Bus volunteers have a regular schedule, which is one day a week, fortnight or month, depending on the particular service they are assigned to.

Bus volunteers assist clients on and off the bus and ensure their comfort and safety. They work as a team together with the bus driver.

The **social bus coordinator** organises social outings for their group, by arranging destinations and passenger lists. They help ensure everyone has a good time.

Shopping bus attendants assist clients by carrying shopping bags to their door or inside their home. However, they do not assist with the actual shopping.
